


Fig. 1: From left to right: Arny Wise (Canada), Jurg Lang, Margery al Chalabi and Suhail al Chalabi (USA) on North American issues.




Fig. 2: Takashi Doi on Japan.




Fig. 3: Alexander B. Leman (Canada) on Housing in India. Sitting in the center, Tom Fookes, Chairman of the Session.
